INFORMATION ON THE EARLY AND REGULAR REGISTRATION DEADLINES

International Arena Aquamasters Swimming Championship organization provides the swimmers with kits. The number of participants and their body sizes have to be determined in advance. This is why we apply two deadlines. Swimmers who register late will receive M (female) and L (male) sized t-shirts.

For enumeration, all swimmers are required to be at the venue at **12:00** with their official licenses for swimming, water polo, triathlon or modern pentathlon with a valid 2019-2020 visa, or a health certificate received in the last six months. Participants are required NOT to wear any protective lotion on their skin. Enumeration will end at **13:15**

COMPETITION RULES



- 1. All swimmers who meet the conditions in the reglement can participate the competition. All participants are deemed to have read and accepted the rules below.**
- The participants of International Aquamasters Open Water Swimming Championship 2008 m. are required to submit at least one of the two following documents: Swimming, Water Polo, Triathlon or Modern Pentathlon License with a valid 2019-2020 visa, or a health certificate received in the last six months. Foreign swimmers will be accredited with their passports and commitment letters.
- The competition will be held under FINA Open Water rules & regulations.
- Medals will be given to swimmers ranked in first 3 in each group in each events. 2008 m. Trophy cups will be awarded to the the first female and the first male swimmer in overall ranking. AquaYouths and Pre-Master swimmers will not be in the overall ranking but they will be given in medal if swimmers ranked in first 3 in their age group in each event.
- All participants who complete the course will receive an e-certificate, which they can download via the provided link.
- Cut-off time for 2008 meters is 90 minutes. Participants who cannot complete the course in specified time will be taken to the boats.
- Referees will be in boats and will warn the swimmers in case of any problems with determined race course. In case of any violation of the rules, referees will disqualify the participant.
- In case referees decide that a swimmer cannot physiologically or psychologically continue the course, the participant will be taken to the boat and disqualified.**
- In case of making intentional contact with any other swimmer, the participant will be disqualified. Any ungentlemanly action will result in a one-year banishment from all championships. In case of repetition, the banishment will be indefinite.**
- Participants are not allowed to wear any kind of watch or jewelry. In case of violation of this rule, the swimmer will be disqualified.
- The swimmers are required to pay their entrance fee to the following account: Tia Tanitim ve Reklamcilik Ltd. Sti, IBAN: **TR68 0006 7010 0000 0062 6381 76** (Yapı ve Kredi Bankası İstanbul Ulus Mahallesi Şubesi). Please add the note **"2K"** to the receipt. Please attach the receipt and individual or team e-registration form (which includes the racetrack preferences and body size) to the application form in **APPLICATION** tab on **www.aquamasters.org** website. The system will not accept incomplete application forms. International swimmers who reside in Turkey are required to follow the steps above for payment. International swimmers who do not reside in Turkey can make swimming race participation fee payments to the accounting officer on site, and collect their receipt.
- Participants who register for a combined event will receive one kit. Kit delivery will take place on the date and time indicated above. Kits will not be delivered or sent to swimmers who does not get their kit in the delivery period due to any reason.**
- Organizational committee reserve the right to change, cancel, correction about the rules of competition published in the present reglement.**
- Aquamasters Board of Directors will have meetings before the championship with Governorship of Muğla, District Governorship of Marmaris, Port Authority of Marmaris, Marine Police and Coast Guard. The organization reserves the right to postpone the competition if there is any situation which will danger the swimmers or accompanying boats. **Aquamasters Board hold the right to cancel the event if the weather conditions will not improve. There will not be any repayment in such case of cancellation. There will not be a repayment in case a swimmer does not participate the championship due to any reason.**
- Awarded swimmers are required to attend the award ceremony, which will host all public and private institutions that supports swimming. If the participant fails to attend the ceremony, the award will be delivered to a fellow against signature, and not be sent in any other ways.
- Registered participants are responsible for all the rules above.**

Consent Letter

1. Swimmers older than 18 have to submit a signed consent letter to the jury.
2. Swimmers younger than 18 have to have the consent letter signed by their parents.
3. Swimmers cannot participate without consent letters.
